


mTransport Bus Technology

Your child's school bus will be participating in the mTransport school bus technology initiative. Students will be receiving a bus card embedded with a Transportation code along with additional information regarding the mTransport information on how to register for the web based parent application.



School bus drivers will have access to their routing information including route mapping, bus stop locations and students assigned to each bus stop location on the route.

The software informs bus drivers of students and their bus stop locations. Drivers will receive notification if a student is boarding the wrong bus or exiting the bus at the wrong bus stop location.

Transportation Code technology allows student's to securely scan their card as they enter and exit the bus. When card information is transmitted in real time, parents/and or guardians who register for the application can receive notification advising the time and location where the student entered and/or exited the bus each day.

Parents/guardians can decide what type of notifications they wish to receive from the application. Notifications can include route timing updates, school arrival and departures and delays.
